



Mayors' Reflection Workshop

Programme overview

Following on from the successful first Mayors' Reflection workshop held in March, Mayors have asked for another gathering where they can meet to discuss their own issues and learn from each other. Mayors agree that there is a lot to be learned from each other's stories and challenges that have been overcome.

Purpose

To provide Mayors with an opportunity for reflection and learning from others in the same situation.

Format

A one-day event which focuses on four key topic sessions. Each session asks groups of Mayors to 'nut out the problem', share their issues and suggestions for the way ahead. The sessions will each end with the start of an action plan and key contacts for further support.

One of these sessions will focus on "Leadership of Mayors During Crises", led by an expert in this field.

Target audience

Mayors, both new and experienced, willing to learn and share with each other.

Topics for exploration and discussion

- › Leadership of Mayor During Crises

Plus three topical sessions for Mayors. We are now taking your suggestions for useful topics which may be similar to:

- › Building good employer relationships
- › Preparing for the future
- › How can we help each other?
- › Mayor and CE partnerships for good, (or Managing CE Performance and quantifying value)
- › What is good Mayoral practice?

The event will end with a shared drinks and nibbles networking session from 4.30pm - 5.30pm.
