



Launch of Safer Journeys

Today the Ministry of Transport launched Safer Journeys, New Zealand's Road Safety Strategy 2010-2020. The Strategy is designed to reduce the number of people injured and killed on New Zealand roads, with a vision for our road safety and a list of actions for central government to work towards. These include proposals to raise the minimum driving age and changing the drink driving limits for young drivers.
