- Big District, Few Ratepayers, Fewer Staff, Lot of Pressure
  - 2,475 km<sup>2</sup>
  - 85,000 residents
  - 14.6% growth 2001-2006
- 1,000 km coastline
- Estuaries/ harbours complicate assessment
  - Orewa, Whangateau, Kaipara

- 557 km
- Muriwai
  - Significant Environment and erosive
- Kaipara – 2<sup>nd</sup> largest Harbour

Helensville, Parakai & WWTP – Low and stopbanked

Stopbanks mix of public/private & they are low!
