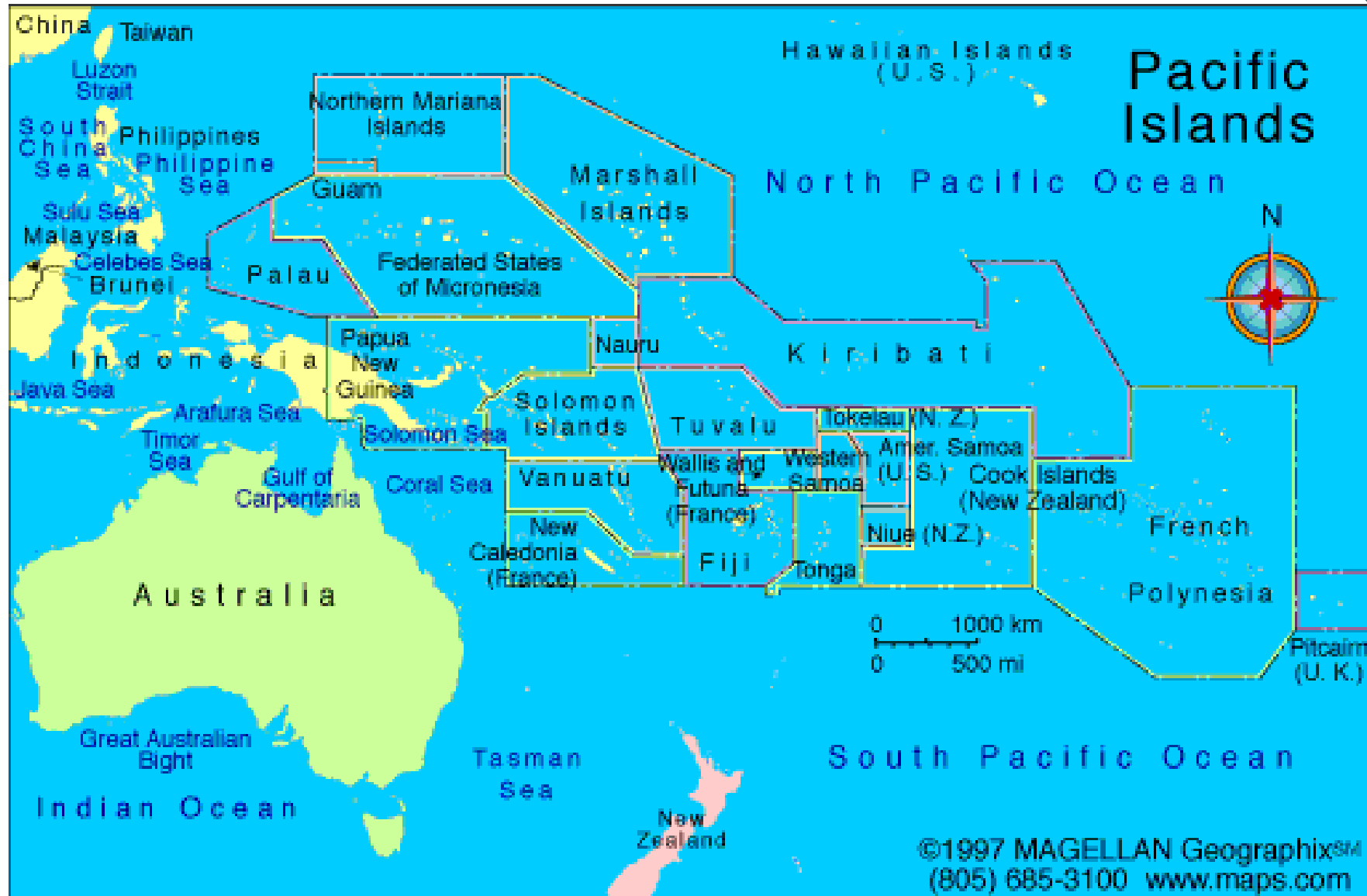

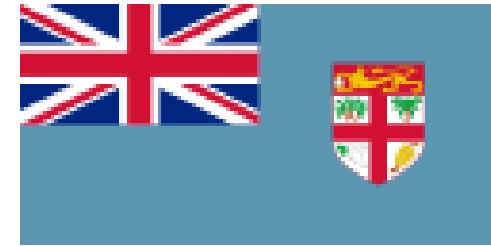

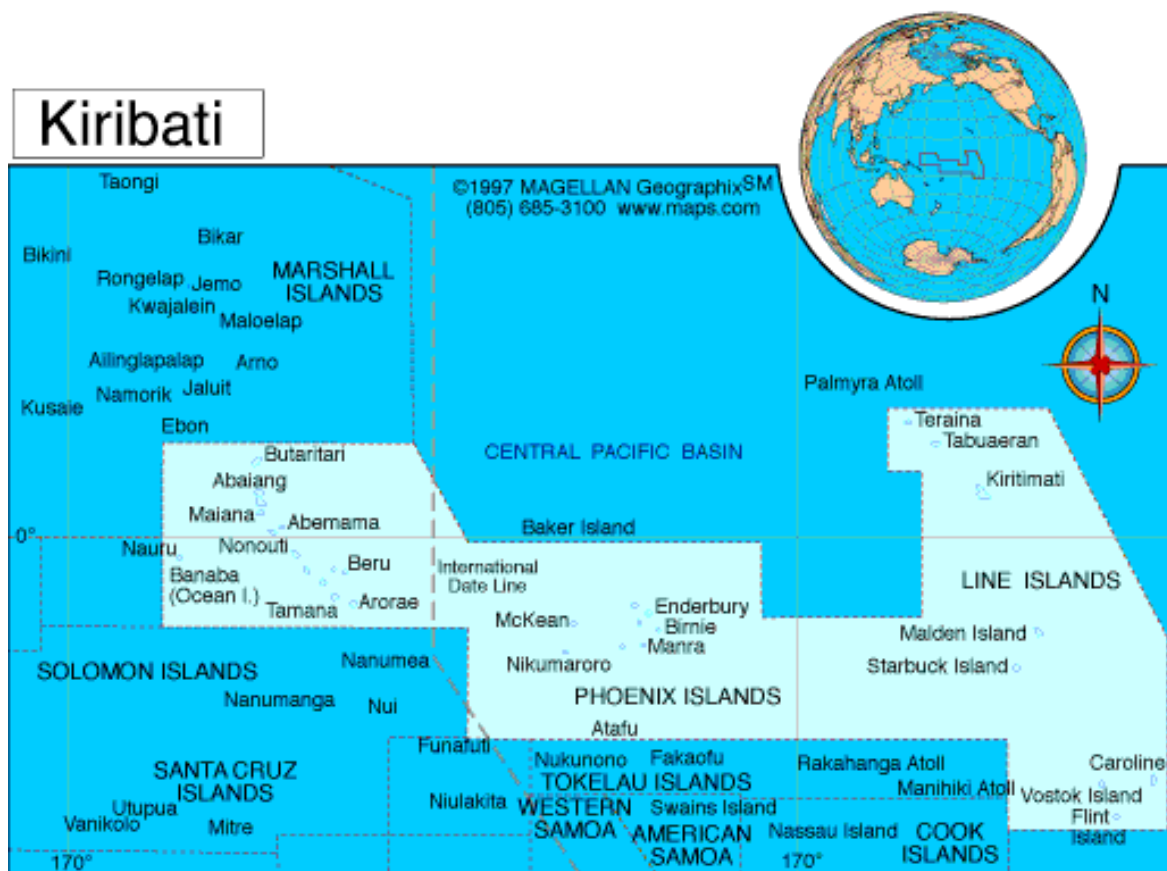
- **Savusavu**

---

- **Betio**

- Islet in Tarawa
- Population 12,500 (living in 1.2km<sup>2</sup>)
- Main commercial centre
- Waste management & revenue generation

- **Teinainano**

- On Tarawa (causeway)
- Population 20,000
- Waste mgt & intergovernmental relations

  - 2,500 kms from Capital
  - Population 6,000
  - Growth Centre (model)
  - Roles and responsibilities
  - Organizational reform

# Papua New Guinea

---

- **Goroka**
  - Capital Eastern Highlands Province
  - Population ext. 40,000
  - Main Commercial centre – institutions, coffee
  - Town planning, environment, urban planning, financial management

# Papua New Guinea

---

- **Kokopo**
  - Provincial Capital, East New Britain
  - Population 22,000
  - New Council
  - Finance and business centre, developing
  - Improve service delivery capacity, corporate planning, urban landscaping, town planning

- **Madang**
  - Provincial capital
  - Population 40,000
  - Administrative and port for the region
  - Industries – meat and fish
  - Town planning, waste management, traffic management, tourism, rating

# The Process

---

1. **Investigations**
2. **In principle commitment**
3. **Scoping visit** (senior political & management representation)
4. **Careful negotiation** (assess scale of involvement, clear and understood objectives)
5. **Identify and agree activities, etc.**

## The Process...

---

6. **Proposal and budget**
7. **Memorandum of Understanding or Cooperation Agreement**
8. **Implementation** – planning, liaison, operations, staff availability, financial management & audit, reporting
9. **A partnership of equals – values based relationships....**

# Responsibilities of Partners/ Resources

---

- **New Zealand Councils**

- Project management
- Preparatory work, investigations & planning
- Liaison with partners, stakeholders
- Avail qualified staff at agreed times
- Local transport, logistics, etc
- Materials & operational costs as decided
- Activity & financial reports

# Responsibilities of Partners/ Resources

---

- **Pacific Councils**

- Project management
- Preparatory work, investigation, planning
- Avail appropriate staff and counterparts at agreed times
- Local transport, logistics, etc
- Materials and operational costs as decided
- Inputs to progress reports

# Responsibilities of Partners/ Resources

---

- **CLGF:**
  - Support to investigations, planning, etc
  - Costs of travel, accommodation, sustenance, related logistics – 3 year funding window
  - Possible operational and material cost support
  - Information dissemination, M&E
  - Liaison with partners, donors
  - Reports to donors, partners
  - Backstopping, support as required
