



About Auckland City Environments

ACE is the regulatory group of the council administering acts, plans, regulations and bylaws that the council is required by various statutes to discharge.

Specifically, ACE undertakes the following regulatory functions for Auckland City:

- Administering Auckland City's District Plan for the Isthmus and Hauraki Gulf Islands.
- Administering the Building Act 2004 as Auckland City's building consent authority.
- Issuing licenses and dispensations for activities identified in bylaws and regulations within Auckland City.
- Monitoring and enforcement across the Isthmus, Hauraki Gulf Islands and the CBD.
- Advocating to central government on behalf of Auckland City on building and housing legislation and standards.
- Advocating on key planning strategies across the city.
- Managing and contributing to major planning and development projects, including the advancement of land use, transport integration and comprehensive development.

Primary functions

- Building consents
- Building inspections
- Resource consents (land use and subdivisions)
- Consent monitoring
- Engineering approvals
- Liquor licenses
- Dog registration
- Enforcement of city bylaws and district plan rules
- Health certificates
- Request for service from public.
