



Mayors' Reflection Workshop

Programme overview

This will be our third Mayors' Reflection workshop where Mayors can meet to discuss issues directly relevant to them and learn from each other. Mayors have told us that there is a lot to be learned from each other's stories and challenges that have been overcome. The workshop is becoming a popular staple in the Mayoral calendar.

Purpose

To provide Mayors with an opportunity for reflection and learning from others in the same situation.

Format

A one-day event which focuses on four key topic sessions. Each session asks groups of Mayors to 'nut out the problem', share their issues, and make suggestions for the way ahead. At the end of each session, each Mayor will have the start of an action plan and key contacts for further support.

One of these sessions will expand on the last workshop's key topic which was well-received. This time we will move from leadership during a crisis to "Learning from a Crisis". This topic will once again be led by Prof Daniel Laufer, PHD, MBA and Associate Professor at Victoria University.

Target audience

Mayors, both new and experienced, willing to learn and share with each other.

Topics for exploration and discussion

1. Learning from a Crisis.

3. Building Mayor/CE relationships
4. Building strategic capability - our own and our team's.
